Entry Requirements

All students must be 18 years or older at the commencement of their course. For any students under the age of 18, an interview may be required.

Academic Requirements

- Successful completion of Australian Year 11 or equivalent; OR
- Completion of Post-Secondary studies (Cert IV or above); OR
- † IELTS requirement when packaged with English is 5.5.
- ‡ with an exit point of 5.5 or higher.
- § Subject to Applicant's Country Assessment Levels.

English Language Requirements

- All students must have a minimum English language proficiency of IELTS 6.0⁺ or equivalent; OR
- Have successfully completed one of the following courses with Greenwich English College or another approved English College: General English (Upper-Intermediate Level 8 weeks), English for Business (12 weeks), Cambridge PET, FCE and CAE, EVS, EAP and IELTS[‡]
- Direct entry to students on passing Greenwich English College Placement Test (online and on-campus testing options[§]).



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
